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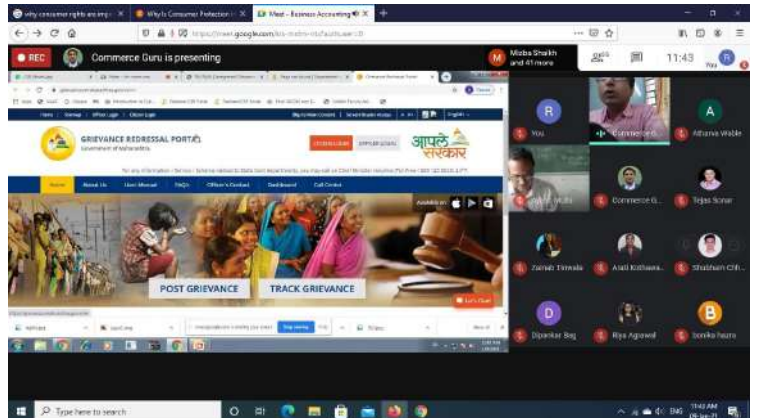

MAKARSANKRANTI- IMPORTANCE OF DAY FOR SOCIAL, ENVIRONMENTAL AND OTHER

Makar Sankranti is one of the ancient Indian festivals which has been observed according to solar cycles, while most festivals are set by the lunar cycle of the lunisolar Hindu calendar. This festival celebrates the solar cycle, it almost always falls on the same Gregorian date every year (January 14), except in some years when the date shifts by a day for that year (January 15). As a result, it can fall on different dates as per the Hindu calendar each year.

Makar Sankranti or Uttarayan or Maghi or simply Sankranti, also known in Bangladesh as Poush. This festival is dedicated to the deity Surya (sun). It is observed that each year the Sun enters the Capricorn zodiac which corresponds with the month of January as per the Gregorian calendar. It marks the first day of the sun's transit into Makara Rashi (Capricorn), marking the end of the month with the winter solstice and the start of longer days.

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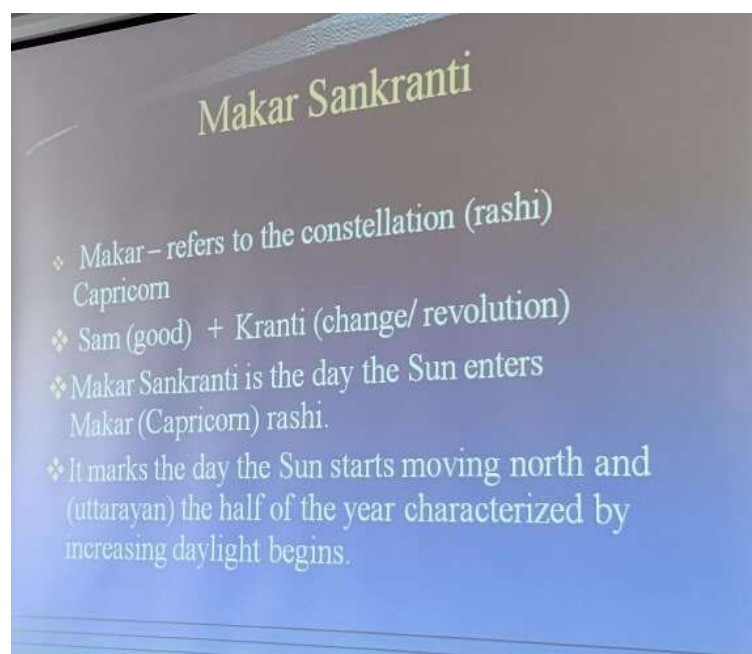


INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT MAKAR SANKRANTI

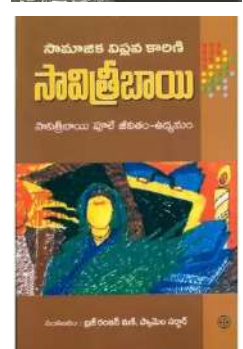
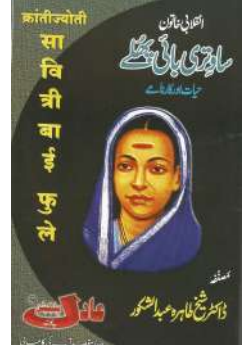
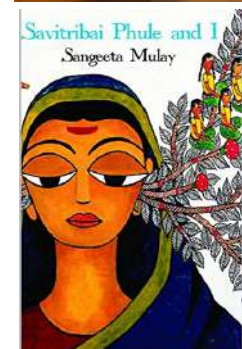
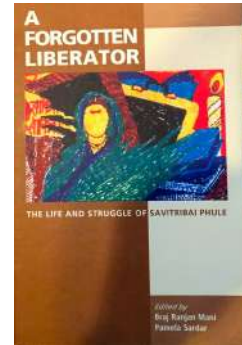
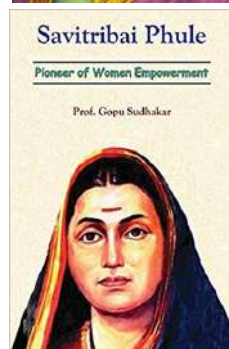
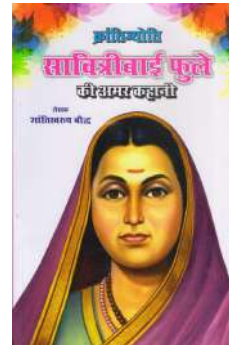


सावित्रीबाई फुले यांच्या सन्मानार्थ 09 August ऑगस्ट २०१९ रोजी पुणे विद्यापीठाचे नाव सावित्रीबाई फुले पुणे विद्यापीठ असे बदलण्यात आले.

सावित्रीबाई फुले यांच्यावर विविध भाषांमधील पुस्तके



- जन्म: 3 जानेवारी 1831, नायगाव, तालूका खंडाळा, सातारा
- 1840 साली जोतिराव फुल्यांशी सावित्रीबाईंचा विवाह झाला. लग्नाच्या वेळी सावित्रीबाईंचे वय नऊ, तर जोतिरावांचे वय तेरा वर्षांचे होते.
- 1 जानेवारी, 1848 रोजी भिडेवाड्यात जोतिराव आणि सावित्रीबाईंनी मुलींची शाळा काढली.
- पुणे येथील यांचे शिक्षण कार्य पाहून 1952 मध्ये इंग्रज सरकारने फुले पतीपत्नीचा मेजर कॅन्डी यांच्या हस्ते जाहीर सत्कार केला आणि शाळांना सरकारी अनुदानही जाहीर केले.
- केशवपन बंद करण्यासाठी व पुनर्विवाहाचा कायदा व्हावा यासाठी प्रयत्न करणे अशी अनेक कामे सावित्रीबाईंनी कल्पकतेने पार पाडली.
- 'काव्यफुले' व 'बावनकशी सुबोध रत्नाकर' हे काव्यसंग्रह त्यांनी लिहिले
- स्त्रियांनी शिकावे हे त्यांचे ब्रीद वाक्य होते.
- अनाथांना आश्रय मिळवा हेही त्याचे कार्यक्षेत्र होते.
- सामाजिक कार्यात त्यांचा पुढाकार असे. त्यामुळेच 1876-77 च्या दुष्काळात त्यांनी खूप कष्ट केले.
- 1897 मध्ये प्लेगची भयंकर साथ आली असताना त्यांनी आपल्या स्वतःच्या प्रकृतीचीही पर्वा न करता प्लेगची लागण झालेल्यांसाठी काम केले. दुर्दैवाने त्या स्वतःच प्लेगच्या भीषण रोगाच्या बळी ठरल्या. 10 मार्च 1897 ला पुण्यात त्यांनी शेवटचा श्वास घेतला.
- 10 मार्च 1998 रोजी भारत सरकारने एक स्मारक टपाल तिकिट सावित्रीबाई फुले यांच्या सन्मानार्थ जारी केले.

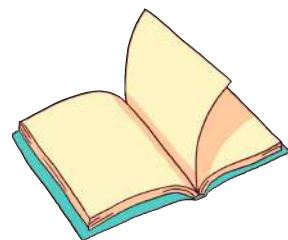
हिंदी भाषा का विकास

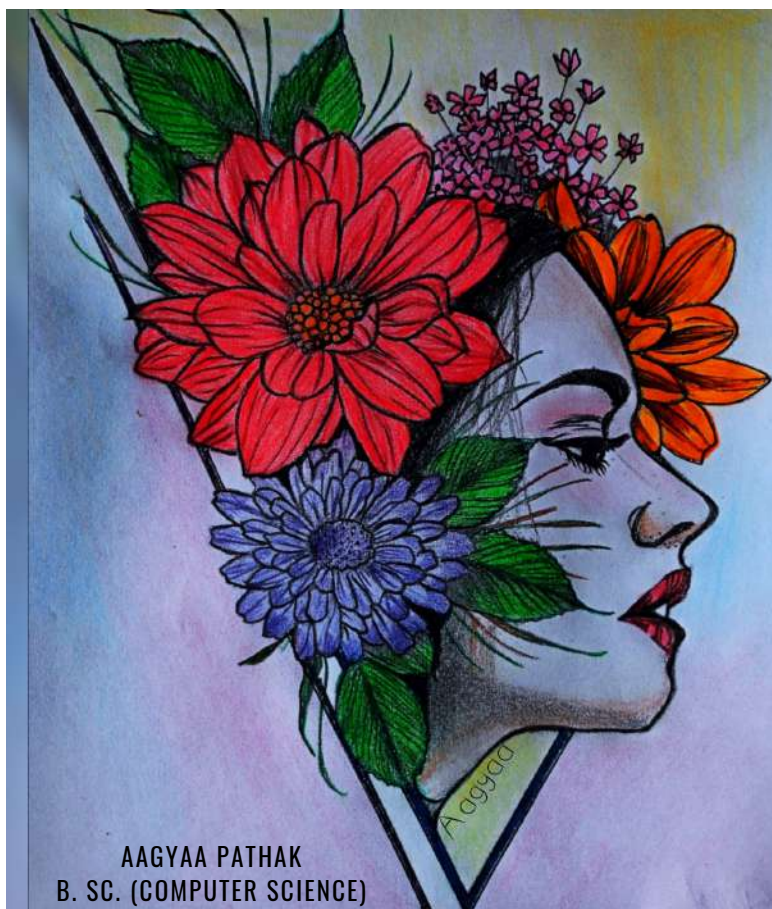

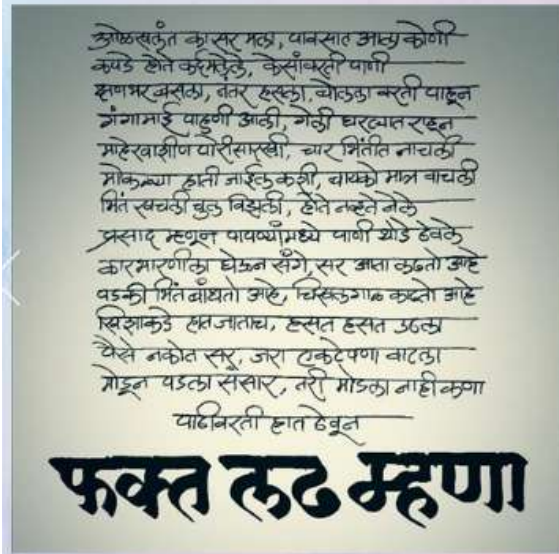

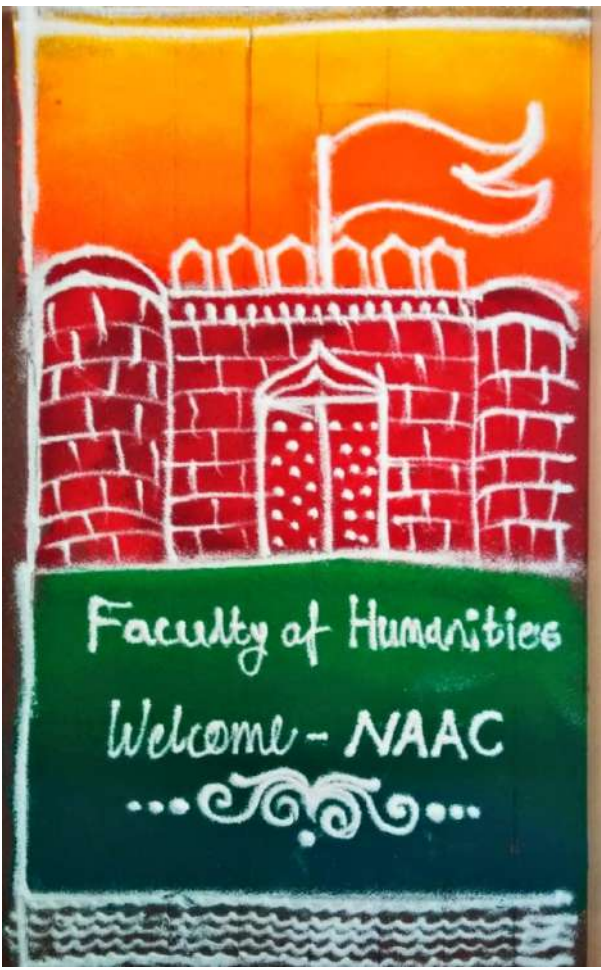

Humans are born with approximately 300 bones, but as they grow some of these bones fuse together. By the time they reach adulthood, they only have 206 bones.

More than half of your bones are located in the hands, wrists, feet, and ankles.

Every second, your body produces 25 million new cells. That means in 15 seconds, you will have produced more cells than there are people in the United States.

The largest bone in the human body is the femur, also known as the thigh bone. The smallest bone is the bone, which is located inside your ear drum.

There is anywhere between 60,000-100,000 miles of blood vessels in the human body. If they were taken out and laid end-to-end, they would be long enough to travel around the world more than three times.

Teeth are considered part of the skeletal system, but are not counted as bones.

Despite accounting for 2% of our body mass, the brain uses 20% of our oxygen and blood supply.

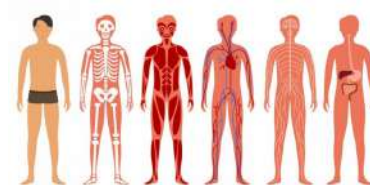
While humans are not the biggest, fastest, or strongest animals around, we are the best at something: long distance running. Our long legs, upright posture, and ability to shed heat via sweat are all factors that make us good runners. 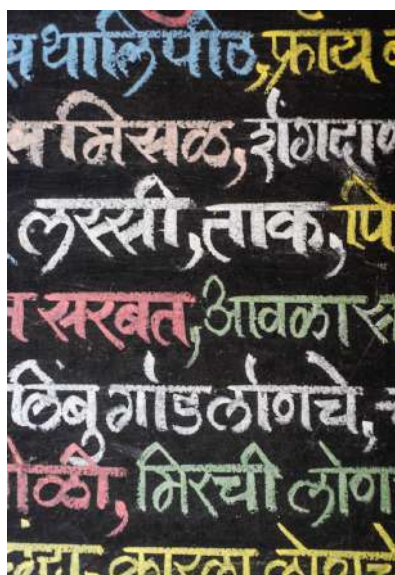
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EAT LOCAL & BE GLOBAL

Are you a type of locavore?? Yes, you heard it right. Locavore are people who actively seek vegetables, fruits, dairy products, eggs and meat that are produced locally. In another simple language, you are that type of person who happily drives a long way just to purchase vegetables or any kind of raw materials which are produced there itself rather than purchasing it from the supermarket. The idea of Locavorism is to eat local food. Basically, it is a movement that aims to connect food producers (farmers) and food buyers (customers) in the same Geographic region to improve local business as well as help in the growth of the local economy. Moreover, eating local food has health benefits, environmental benefits and economic benefits. Eating local food is not rocket science but it is a simple food that is grown in your own region organic food, Fresh Food, seasonal food. When we are focusing on the benefits of having local food then I must talk about 7 things with you and these are as follows-

- Tastes Better – Local food tastes better because it hasn't lost nutrients or started to spoil since its harvest.
- Less Waste – Because the food was grown locally and delivered more quickly, less of it gets spoiled on the way to the table.
- Fresher Food – Freshness comes hand-in-hand with a quick, local delivery shortly after harvest.
- Improved Allergies – Eating local food exposes people to the allergens they're most likely to come in contact with, thereby "vaccinating" the consumer to better resist those allergens.
- Shorter Travel time – The food travels shorter distances from field to plate, which greatly reduces CO2 emissions involved in trucking or flying the same food from across the country.

- Strengthening the Local Economy – Spending your money with local growers adds direct fuel to the local economy since those

growers buy supplies and pay bills locally. But there are few disadvantages of shopping for local has seen such as

2. Typically find smaller quantity selection of food offered by the local farmers.
3. Permissibility of local food is more as it's not treated with the preservatives.

MYSTERY AND HISTORY BEHIND THE MONTHS

January, February March, etc what are all of these? you will think what foolish I am, these are the names of months simple right; but what did you think that how these months are got their unique names? No, then let's see the Mystery and history behind the months names

January

January is “the month of Janus” the Roman god of beginnings and endings. Janus presided over doors and gates—appropriate for the beginning of the year. Indeed, Janus was usually depicted with faces looking backward and forward, as is characteristic of a new year.

February

February, “the month of cleansing,” is derived from februa, the name of a Roman purification festival held on the 15th of this month.

March

March is named after the god of war and a planet: Mars. In ancient Rome, several festivals of Mars took place in March because that was the earliest month of the year when the weather was mild enough to start a war. At one time, March was the first month in the Roman calendar. The Romans changed the order of months several times between the founding of Rome and the fall of the Roman Empire.

April

April is from the Latin Aprillis, which is a derivative of the Latin base apero-, meaning “second.” April was named as such because of the tweaking of the ancient Roman calendar, where April was the second month.

May

May springs from the Greek goddess Maia, daughter of Atlas and mother of Hermes. She was a nurturer and an earth goddess, which certainly explains her connection with this springtime month, when flowers and crops burst forth.

June

June descends from Juno, wife of Jupiter, and the Roman ancient goddess of marriage and childbirth.

July

July was named in honor of Julius Caesar right after his assassination in 44 B.C., with July being the month of his birth. July is the first month in the calendar that bears the name of a real person, rather than a deity.

August

August represents another Roman ruler having been enshrined. In 8 B.C., the month Sextilis (“sixth”) was renamed after Augustus, nephew of Julius Caesar and the first emperor of Rome. The emperor's name came from the Latin Augustus, which gave rise to the adjective “august,” meaning “respected and impressive.”

September

September, from the Latin septem (“seven”), seems as if it should be the seventh month of the year.

Others

The names for October (octo), November (novem), and December (decem) suggest that they would be the eighth, ninth, and tenth months. And they once were, when the Roman lunar calendar started the year in March at harvest time. But all that changed in 46 B.C., when January became the first month of the new Julian calendar, making September through December the ninth–twelfth months of the year.

- The Gregorian calendar differs from the solar year by 26 seconds per year.
- Before 46 B. C. calendar was of 10 Months and and each month has 29-30 days which makes confusion and remains 60 days uncounted in 46 B. C. Julius Caesar has modified the calendar system of 12 Moths with 30 to 31 days
- The Gregorian calendar is based on the sun.
