Mrs. Mrudula Jadhav worked as a coordinator. Feedbacks are received from the participants after the webinar.



Cleanliness was very close to Mahatma Gandhi's heart. A clean India is the best tribute we can pay to Bapu when we celebrate his 150th birth anniversary in 2019. Mahatma Gandhi devoted his life so that India attains 'Swarajya'. Now the time has come to devote ourselves towards 'Swachchhata' (cleanliness) of our motherland.

To accelerate the efforts to achieve universal sanitation coverage and to put the focus on sanitation, the Prime Minister of India had launched the Swachh Bharat Mission on 2nd October 2014. Under the mission, all villages, Gram Panchayats, Districts, States and Union Territories in India declared themselves "open-defecation free" (ODF) by 2 October 2019, the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, by constructing over 100 million toilets in rural India. To ensure that the open defecation-free behaviors are sustained, no one is left behind, and that solid and liquid waste management facilities are accessible, the Mission is moving towards the next Phase II of SBMG i.e ODF-Plus. ODF Plus activities under Phase II of Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) will reinforce ODF behaviors and focus on providing interventions for the safe management of solid and liquid waste in villages.




Webinar on Guidelines for AQAR One more step towards Success...

DeFi Renaissance of Financial Systems By Anoop Mohanta

The concept of decentralization started back in 2009 when a presumed pseudonymous named Satoshi Nakamoto started bitcoin; the first decentralized currency. The term Decentralised finance(Defi) was coined in August 2018 by a few developers of Ethereum on a telegram chat. They were discussing what to call the movement of open financial applications and ended up with the name Defi. The first usage of Defi was in December 2017 when MakerDAO was launched. It's a decentralized lending platform that was built on the Ethereum blockchain.

Meaning and purpose

Defi is a collective term for financial products and services that are accessible to anyone with an internet connection. They are run and managed by codes which are called smart contracts. It is a movement that allows users to utilize financial services such as borrowing, lending, and trading without the need to rely on centralized entities. The purpose of Defi is to the middlemen, remove bring more transparency, make it accessible to everyone and increase the efficiency of traditional financial services.

Decoding Defi—Layers of Defi

Blockchain Layer: It's the foundation layer that stores data such as transaction history and state of accounts.

Assets Layer: It consists of assets that are issued on the blockchain example tokens and currencies.

Protocols Layer: It provides standards for use cases of Dapps(Decentralised Apps) which are called smart contracts.

Applications Layer: It's created the front-end of the applications which are linked with smart contracts.

Aggregator Layer: It's an extension to the application layer which creates user-centric platforms that connect to several applications and protocols.

Categories

Stablecoins: To eradicate the volatility of the crypto market Stablecoins were created which are pegged with stable assets such as USD. Examples: USDT, USDC, etc

Exchanges: Decentralised exchanges aim to solve the issue of centralized exchanges by allowing users to exchange cryptocurrencies without giving up custody of the coins. Examples: AirSwap, io, Barterdex, etc

Derivatives: A derivative is a contract whose value is derived from another underlying asset such as stocks, commodities, currencies, indexes, bonds, or interest rates. Traders can use derivatives to hedge their positions and decrease their risk in any particular trade. Defi platforms are starting to build derivatives markets.

Fund Management: It means overseeing and managing the cash flow to generate returns on your investments. You can manage your decentralized assets by Zapper Finance, Zerion, Defi Saver, etc

Lending and borrowing: Decentralisation eases the lending and borrowing process by removing the mediators. You can collateralize your digital assets to borrow money.

Insurance: It's a risk management strategy in which an individual receives financial protection if an unfortunate event happens. You can now get insurance for smart contracts failure and exchange hacks. Examples: Nexus Mutual, Unslashed Finance, etc

Payments: A key role of cryptocurrency is to allow decentralized and trustless value transfer between two parties. The possibility of providing payments as streams.

Merits

Transparency: Anyone can inspect and scrutinize the codes.

Immutability: Alteration of information is not possible.

Accessibility: Anyone can access it with an internet connection.

Transparency: Hackers could exploit the codes **Immutability:** Errors could multiply into something larger.

Scalability: The bandwidth of a Dapp is limited to its blockchain.

Existing banking problems and solutions by DeFi

- Efficiency: In banks, payments may take days due to manual process but in Defi you can transfer your funds within minutes.
- **Transparency:** Banks are closed books you cannot see their record of managed assets but in Defi, you can audit everything.
- **Restrictions:** Certain types of people who have an x number of credit scores or assets can take loans but in Defi, anyone can take the loan.
- **Mismanagement:** You have to trust companies not to mismanage your money for instance giving loans to risky borrowers but in Defi you manage your money.
- Freedom: Banks hold your money but in Defi you hold it.

Risks in DeFi

- **Tech Risk:** Smart contract is a bunch of codes that are written by humans and there could be a possibility of errors that could become a loophole for hackers.
- Asset Risk: Crypto-assets used as collateral may sharply decline in value because of cryptocurrencies but this problem has been solved by stable coins.
- **Product Risk**: There's no regulation or insurance on your money when you use Defi. Between Jan-April 2021, \$156 million was stolen in DeFi-related hacks, according to Cipher Trace.

Conclusion

Defi is still in its nascent stage and a lot of development is yet to be done. We can see many scams are happening around but don't forget it also has many positive sides as discussed above. Many developers are working to eradicate problems of DeFi and in the future buying loans, transferring funds, lending money, etc from Defi platforms could be the new normal. If you go back in between the late '90s to early 2000s similar things were happening with the internet—there were a lot of company scams, everyone was starting his .com company, people were not comfortable buying products online but look at today as technology got evolved so do our trust with internet companies and we could see great companies like Google, Instagram, Amazon and many more coming out from it. In my opinion, the same thing may happen with Defi but I'd suggest doing your thorough research before buying anything from Defi platforms and keep a track of things happening in this space because you might find an opportunity or idea to build your own company around it.





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
